Article 1: Moderator — Jeannine Young was nominated, 1 vote cast. Voice carried, passed.

Article 2: Auditors' Report was given by Cheryl Bailey and Michael Waterhouse

Article 3: To elect all Town Officers:

- Select Board Member for a term of 3 years: Alison Blaney and Lucas Schulz nominated. Alison Blaney 88 votes, Lucas Schulz 68 votes.
- Lister for a term of 3 years: Harry Miller nominated. Voice carried, passed.
- Auditor for a term of 3 years: Craig Taylor nominated. Voice carried, passed.
- Cemetery Commissioner for a term of 5 years: James Jones nominated. Voice carried, passed.
- Trustee of Public Funds for a term of 3 years: Leslie Taylor nominated. Voice carried, passed.
- WWII Memorial Fund Trustee for a term of 3 years: Michael Martin nominated. Voice carried, passed.

Article 4: Authorize total fund expenditures for operating expenses of \$960,863.00 of which \$648,292.17 shall be raised by taxes and \$312,570.83 by non-tax revenues? 107 yes/7 no.

Article 5: Appropriate \$65,000 to the Craftsbury Fire Department for payment of necessary expenses from January 1, 2024 through December 31, 2024? 98 yes/3 no.

Article 6: Appropriate \$10,000 to the Craftsbury Fire Department for paying stipends to its volunteers? Voice carried, passed.

Article 7: Appropriate \$12,400 for the following? Voice carried, passed.

- \$1,500 Craftsbury Block Party Fund
- \$6,400 Craftsbury Cemeteries, for mowing
- \$2,500 Craftsbury Recreation Committee, with \$1,500 allocated to swimming lessons in Greensboro
- \$ 500 Craftsbury Historical Society
- \$1,500 Craftsbury Village Improvement Society, for maintenance on the Common **TOTAL \$12,400**

Article 8: Appropriate \$7,000 for the Craftsbury Conservation Fund, money set aside for future conservation projects? Voice carried, passed.

Article 9: Appropriate \$6,000 for Craftsbury Saplings, a community children's center? Amendment to original article to reduce the amount to \$1,400 failed with a paper vote of 26 yes/86 no. Original article voice carried, passed.

Article 10: Appropriate \$ 12,000 for Craftsbury Community Care Center, a residential care home providing support to elders? Voice carried, passed.

Article 11: Appropriate \$13,700 for the following? Voice carried, passed.

Article 17: Vote to collect taxes July 15, September 15, and November 15. Voice carried, passed

Article 18: Discussion nonbinding business. Barn Dance May 18, Antiques & Uniques is back, July 13. Craftsbury Old Home Day, the 2nd Saturday in August.
